SO WHAT ARE FOYER GROUPS?

Foyer Group Pot-Luck Dinners are a fun and easy way for parishioners to gather together on a regular but informal basis for purely social reasons—to enjoy one another’s company, to strengthen bonds of community, to meet new members and just to get to know other people who share a common interest in Grace but with whom we might not otherwise interact. They provide a means to develop new friendships and deepen old ones and are a way to make our sometimes-too-large-seeming parish feel smaller and warmer.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Groups of 8 - 12 are randomly made up of singles, couples, young people, retired folks, etc. Newcomers are especially invited to join one of the groups at any time. Groups generally meet every 4 to 6 weeks after the Kick Off through May in the home of one of the members for a Pot- Luck Dinner. How the group want the dinners to go is limited only by the collective imagination of the group, but the main idea if for the gatherings to simply focus on Christian fellowship, a refreshing meal and relaxed conversation.
